Employment Rights

General Information: Bet Tzedek's Employment Rights Project represents low-wage workers who are asserting claims for unpaid wages and unsafe working conditions. We need volunteers to interview potential clients during our evening clinic on Wednesdays from 5:30pm to 7:30pm in our North Hollywood office (Coldwater Canyon and Victory Blvd.). The clinic is a great chance to sharpen your legal skills and learn about case development and strategy. Volunteers who can make an additional time commitment may have an opportunity to represent clients at an administrative hearing.

Minimum Time Commitment: Two hours once a week or once a month for the Wednesday evening clinic positions. If it is easier for volunteers to drive to our office earlier in the afternoon on Wednesdays, we can provide office space where volunteers can study or work until the clinic starts.

Qualifications: **Volunteers must be proficient in spoken Spanish** and have strong interpersonal skills, as well as an understanding of, and empathy with, the experiences and problems of low-income persons and immigrants. Volunteers must be attorneys, paralegals, paralegal students, or law school students/graduates (or planning to go to law school).
