An internationally recognized force in poverty law, Bet Tzedek was founded in 1974 to achieve full and equal access to justice for all vulnerable members of our community. Bet Tzedek's vision inspires our pioneering and expansive initiatives, and has forged one of today's leading centers for social justice.

Now, more than 37 years later, Bet Tzedek continues to create unique, practical, and effective strategies to address the major problems confronting the more than two million Angelenos disenfranchised by poverty. Bet Tzedek's projects combine direct legal representation with powerful outreach, education, and legislative advocacy. Each year our 68 staff members provide services that impact the lives of more than 15,000 people of every racial and religious background. Our programs secure the basic necessities of life, and are run by staff with deep expertise in elderlaw, housing, public benefits, consumer issues, employment rights, and impact litigation.

Bet Tzedek creates strategic, innovative programs that radically and effectively leverage our expertise to serve vulnerable groups throughout the country. We build high-capacity networks of specialized volunteer attorneys that last year provided almost 57,000 donated hours, valued at \$16 million. In addition, working with our national partners, Bet Tzedek leads the Holocaust Survivors Justice Network – a groundbreaking initiative which is now helping thousands of clients in more than 30 cities in the United States. In 2009, this unprecedented program received the American Bar Association's Pro Bono Publico Award, the National Law Journal's Pro Bono Award, and the Pro Bono Institute and Association of Corporate Counsel's Pro Bono Partner Award.
